

## **Mentor Coordinator:**

The Mentor Coordinator works to assign each Fellow to a person to mentor and disciple them during their time as a Fellow and throughout their life. The coordinator strives to match individuals with commonalities, and those who will challenge and grow one another.

The objective of the mentoring component of the Fellows program is to provide each Fellow with guidance and encouragement from an older believer who has worked in corporate business, ministry, or the community.

The influence of a Mentor in a younger person's life can be significant, and the impact is related directly to the willingness of the Mentor to share personal life experiences with a younger person who is open to learning from such a friend. The Fellow should expect and will depend on weekly contact from their Mentor.

The Mentor Coordinator will provide written guidelines to the Mentors at beginning of the year and will train them to serve as cheerleaders, a sounding board, a prayer partner, a guidance counselor, and an encourager. The coordinator will instill flexibility in format, confidentiality, and ensuring that Fellows and Mentors are consistently meeting once a week. The Mentor Coordinator will help instill in the Mentors the belief that they are investing in a friend for life.
